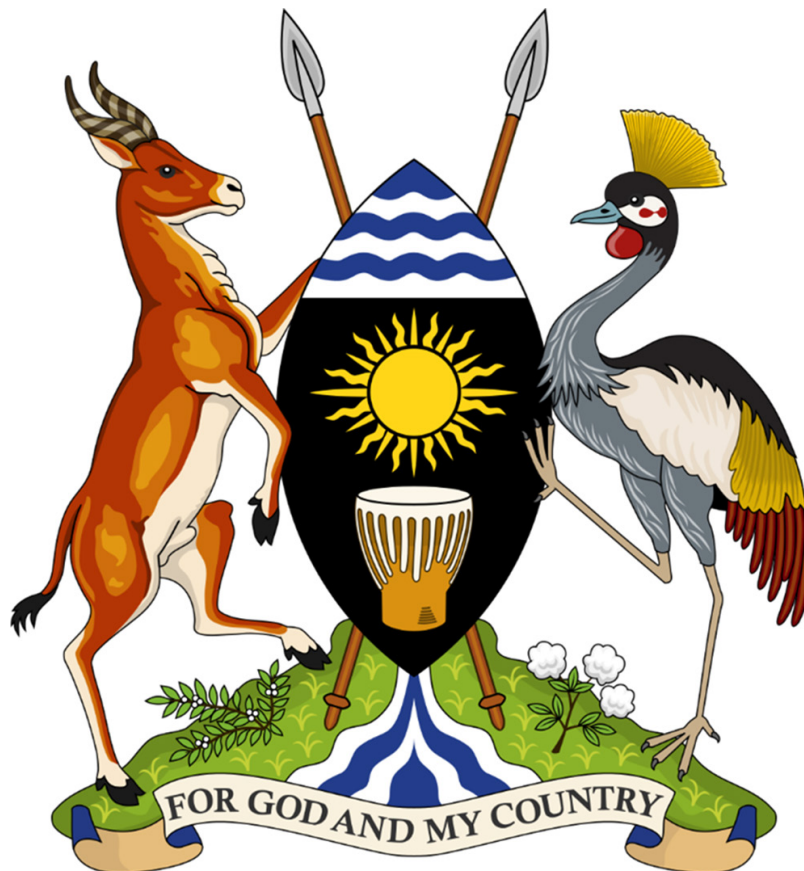

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OUR VISION

The Freedom Tablet Initiative exists to solve the single greatest challenge of our time:
how to deliver safe, high-quality education to every child, even where traditional systems cannot reach.

We believe that every nation, regardless of geography or infrastructure, deserves the tools to educate its children.

We believe that learning must be accessible offline, protected from harmful content, and adapted to local culture and curriculum.

We believe that technology must support teachers, not replace them.

We believe that children in rural villages, refugee settlements, and underserved schools deserve the same opportunity as children in the capital.

The Freedom Tablet is a new model for national education delivery.

It combines durable hardware, offline content, solar capability, and culturally aligned programs to give each country a complete, independent education system that does not rely on the internet, electricity, or external providers.

Education everywhere, for everyone.

Safe. Offline. Solar-powered.

Built for the children who need it most.

THE PROBLEM WE SOLVE

Uganda has one of the youngest populations on earth.

Every year, millions of children enter a school system that is growing faster than the nation's infrastructure, teacher supply, and electricity network.

Rural communities remain far from centralized services.

Many families have no access to stable power or internet.

Teachers are stretched across large class sizes, and thousands of children still learn without consistent materials or guidance.

These challenges are not failures.

They are the reality of a rapidly growing nation with wide geography, diverse regions, and a population driven by youth.

Traditional education systems cannot scale quickly enough.

Building schools and hiring teachers at the rate required would take decades.

Internet-based learning is not practical for most families, and online access introduces safety risks for children.

Uganda needs an education model that works in every district, every village, and every household - regardless of electricity, connectivity, or teacher availability.

The Freedom Tablet Initiative provides a solution designed specifically for this reality.

A fully offline, solar-ready, curriculum-aligned education system that reaches every child without depending on infrastructure.

This is how Uganda can strengthen literacy, support teachers, and give every young learner a fair and equal start.

THE FREEDOM TABLET

The Freedom Tablet is designed specifically for regions where children cannot rely on electricity, internet, or stable infrastructure.

It is durable, offline, solar-ready, and preloaded with learning programs aligned to national priorities. It functions anywhere: in the classroom, at home, in rural villages, and in communities far from central services.

Key features include:

- Fully offline operation

- Safe, protected environment for children

- National curriculum content

- English and early-learning modules

- Solar charging capability

- Rugged construction



Offline learning is not a limitation. It is safety, dignity, and access.

The Freedom Tablet Initiative includes a complete ecosystem of learning tools.

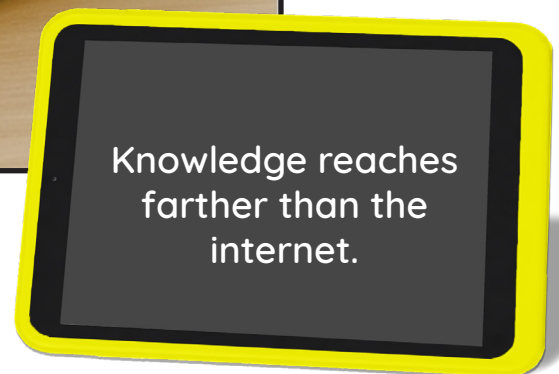
Toddler Tablet, early learning and foundational skills

Lifeline Tablet, crisis zones, refugee settlements, off-grid communities

Each tablet is fully offline and operates independently of connectivity. Together, they form a full-spectrum national education system.



YOUR CURRICULUM ON OUR TABLET

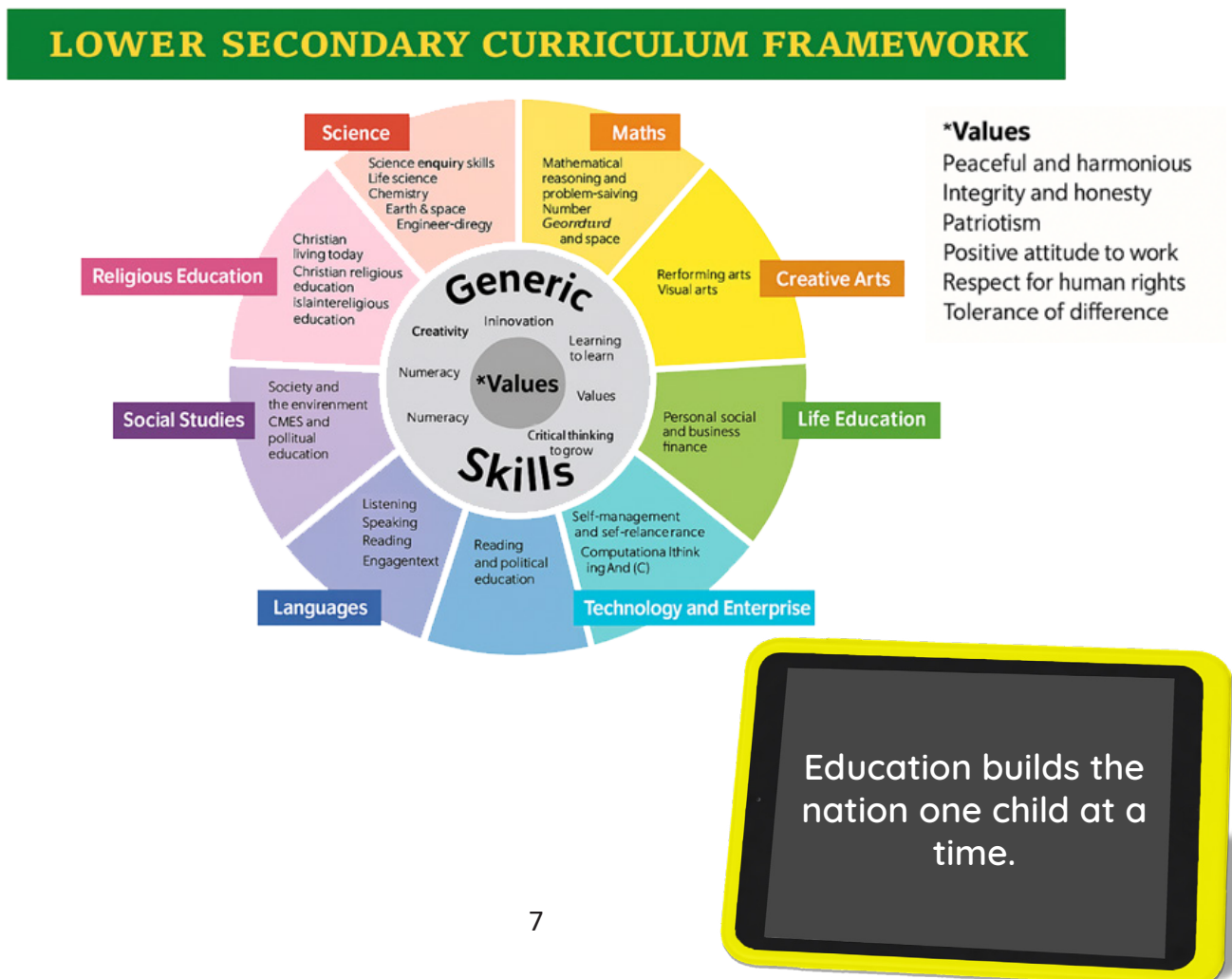
The Freedom Tablet Initiative is fully aligned with Uganda's national primary education curriculum as guided by the National Curriculum Development Centre.

We understand the importance of competency-based learning, indigenous language development, and locally relevant educational materials.

Our tablet is preloaded with Uganda's approved learning outcomes for primary education. Content supports indigenous languages alongside English. Lessons follow competency-based approaches, interactive learning, and inclusive education. Teacher guides, learner materials, and references used by NCDC are adapted for offline access.

Curriculum updates can be delivered through MECs or Hubs, ensuring the tablet evolves with national standards.

A Freedom Tablet in a classroom or household delivers a complete Uganda-primary-education package that respects national standards, works in rural environments, and supports teachers and schools across the country.



MASTER HOOBEE in OVILLE

Master Hoobee is a warm animated teacher created to improve early-childhood English, phonics, and confidence.

His Magic Mouth system supports accent-free pronunciation. He helps teachers manage large classes by delivering consistent, structured lessons that work in any region.

Master Hoobee gives every young learner the same strong start, whether in Kampala, Karamoja, or a rural village.

IDEA's unique incorporation of Oville World provides a fully immersive accent free English-speaking environment where children can hone their skills.

TANGIBLE ASSETS

The Freedom Tablet Initiative is built on real, deployable assets.

Tablets: Toddler, Youth, Adult, Indigenous

Mobile Education Centres: solar-powered container units for updates and training

Freedom Hubs: regional support, repair, and distribution

Kiosks: community micro-centres for service

Uganda can deploy these assets immediately and scale at its own pace.

MANUFACTURING AND SUPPLY CHAIN

The Freedom Tablet platform is supported by a global supply chain with manufacturing capacity in Canada, Asia, and the Middle East. As the Initiative expands, Uganda can participate directly through local assembly, technical servicing, and regional distribution.

Uganda is well positioned to become an East African assembly hub. Local centres for tablet assembly, repairs, and training can be established, creating employment and supporting long-term national ownership.

New manufacturing capacity emerging in Indonesia, through investment networks connected to Uganda, provides an additional pathway for sourcing components and developing regional production. Over time, tablets can be partially manufactured in Asia and assembled in Uganda, strengthening capacity and reducing reliance on imports.

This model ensures sustainability while giving Uganda a role in the future Pan-African education hardware ecosystem.



USE CASES

Uganda

Youth Tablet and Master Hoobee supporting early literacy, national curriculum access, and rural outreach across all regions.

Somalia

Adult civic tablet and youth-safety programs promoting national unity, informed citizenship, and protection from harmful influences.

Refugee Regions

Lifeline Tablet and Portable Education Centres providing offline, solar-powered learning where education is most difficult to deliver.

Canada

First Nations language and cultural preservation through community-led content, digital language houses, and safe offline learning for children and youth.

Youth in Crisis Zones

Counter-recruitment and positive identity programs delivered through culturally aligned storytelling, interactive learning, and safe offline environments that present healthy options, purpose, and national pride.

These examples show how the Freedom Tablet Initiative adapts to different national needs while remaining fully offline, safe, and deployable at scale.



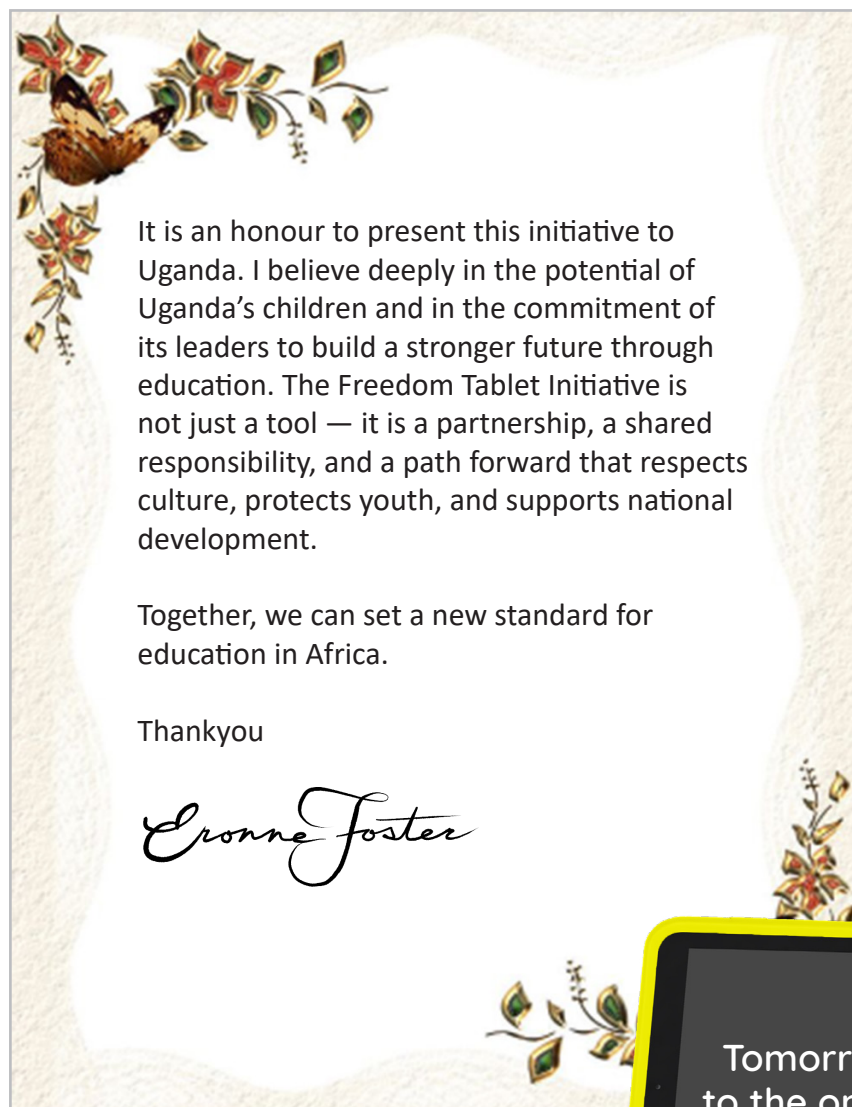
